REGISTRATIONS

W1 Entries

W1 Paddlers may only paddle for one region at the 2005 Nationals Champs.

Closing date for W1 entries is 30/11/04. There are a couple of regions who have their trials scheduled for December. Regional Reps will have until the 12/12/04 to complete regional entries.

W1 Waka

Regions have requested an increase in allocation of waka for the event.

Regions are permitted to bring additional waka, however, please be mindful that storage space in the loading bay will be limited as we will have W6 and W12 waka to store on Wednesday and Thursday.

Therefore, regions are encouraged to be realistic about the number of waka you bring. Waka will be stored in regional areas and regional co-ordinators are responsible for organising who brings the waka for their region.

W1 Waka weigh in will occur on Wednesday afternoon. No waka will be weighed on Thursday. NKOA will not be responsible for W1 waka. You may take your waka away, but they must be in the loading bay compound by 7.00am Thursday morning. E nga mana e nga matawaka tena koutou katoa

W6 SENIOR MASTERS/KAUMATUA/KUIA
