- ☛ 250m course for turn races - W6 1000m and 1500m events (8 lanes).

**Canoe Type:** W6 – Mahi Mahi  
W1 – Any design

**REGISTRATIONS**

Club co-ordinators are to complete registration on arrival at Karapiro. The admin office will be open from 2pm Sunday 14 January 2006.

**ID CARDS**

**W1 WAKA WEIGH IN**

W1 Waka must be weighed by Wednesday 17 January 2007.

W1 Waka weighing will commence Sunday 14 January at 2.00pm through to Monday 15 January 5pm. Tuesday and Wednesday 3pm – 5pm. No weighing outside these times.

W1 owners will be responsible for providing weights for their waka. Minimum weight is 16kg.

Waka will be checked at loading bay prior to racing.

***Weights must be of suitable standard and visible.***
