In follow up to the meeting with senior women on Friday 19 January 2006 (at Results Area at the National Sprints Competition), this panui serves to reconfirm Corrina Gage's korero seeking out senior women (open division and above) who are interested in a selection opportunity for international long distance racing.

At this meeting Corrina outlined the following, that:

- UPDATED 24.01.07: This is not a NKOA activity but efforts are being made to work with NKOA High Performance Development activity to align ourselves with NKOA and thereby gain sanctioning
- The aim is to build on NZ paddler capability from the work done pre-World and at World sprints to take it to another level in distance paddling
- It targets generally interested long distance paddlers for ocean racing
- UPDATED 24.01.07: It has the ultimate aim of the women's Molokai'i race (Na Wahine o Ke kai Outrigger Canoe Race) 2008 in Hawaii. Goals towards this will be:
 - Kona in September 2007 (Queen Lili'uokalani Outrigger Canoe Race)
 - Molokai'i race in October 2007 (Na Wahine o ke kai Outrigger Canoe Race)
 - Hauraki Hoe and Tauranga Harbour Challenge competitions in 2008
 - Molokai'i race in Sept/Oct 2008 (Na Wahine o ke kai Outrigger Canoe Race)

Note: it is anticipated that paddlers who make the cut would choose between Kona and Molokai'i as there is 3 weeks between these races.

• It will at this time be self funded but efforts will be made to seek funding
