OPEN AWARDS

BAYLEYS REAL ESTATE SPORTSWOMAN OF THE YEAR

Open to any female individual who has excelled in one or more sports.

GALAXY UNITED TRAVEL SPORTSMAN OF THE YEAR

Open to any male individual who has excelled in one or more sports.

BAYTRUST COACH OF THE YEAR

Open to any coach who has excelled in one or more sports.

REFEREE/UMPIRE OF THE YEAR

Open to any referee or umpire who has excelled in one or more sports.

CNS TEAM OF THE YEAR

Open to teams that have performed to exceptional standards during the year.

CLASSIC HITS ROTORUA JUNIOR SPORTSPERSON OF THE YEAR

Open to any individual between the ages of 15 - 21 years as at 01 October 2008 who has excelled in one or more sports.

DELTA CORPORATION CLUB OF THE YEAR

Open to all clubs, sub associations and centres that have competed successfully, shown an outstanding ability to provide for its members and contributed to the community.

All nominations must be endorsed by the appropriate governing Regional Sports Organisation.

SERVICE TO SPORT AWARDS

Each individual sporting code is invited to select its own winner in this award category. This award must be made by the governing Regional Sports Organisation and can be awarded to anybody involved in that code that has made a significant contribution to that sport. There is no official period of eligibility for the Service to Sport Award Category. All winners will be presented with a Service to Sport Award on the night.

Where there is no Regional Sports Organisation for a particular sport, a decision should be made unanimously by the majority of the sports clubs in the BOP area.

SPORTSWOMAN & SPORTSMAN OF THE YEAR

- An outstanding Sports Person who has performed to an exceptional level in the 2007/08 specified year.
- A sportsperson who has represented the region with distinction.
- Has performed with a sense of Fair play.
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to the sport and the region.

COACH OF THE YEAR

- Has made an outstanding contribution in the area of coaching in the 2007/08 specified year.
- Achieved results at the highest possible level within their sport.
- Has showed an innovative approach to coaching.
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to the sport and the region.
- Has performed with a sense of Fair play.

REFEREE/UMPIRE OF THE YEAR

- Has made an outstanding contribution in the area of umpiring / refereeing in the 2007/08 specified year.
- Achieved results at the highest possible level within their sport.
- An official who is consistently mentioned by players as being fair and consistent
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to the sport and the region.

BEST TEAM PERFORMANCE

- An outstanding Team who has performed to an exceptional level in the 2007/08 specified year.
- A team who has represented the region with distinction.
- The team performed with a sense of Fair play.
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to the sport and the region.

JUNIOR SPORTSPERSON OF THE YEAR

- Nominees must be between the ages of 15 - 21 years as at 01 October 2008.
- An outstanding Junior Sports Person who has performed to an exceptional level in the 2007/08 specified year.
- A junior sportsperson who has represented the region with distinction.
- Has performed with a sense of Fair play.
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to the sport and the region.

SERVICE TO SPORT

- Has given at least 10 years of service.
- Held Offices or made a substantial contribution within their sport in the region, and / or nationally.
- Has made a significant contribution to sport in general in the region.
- Has made a contribution to the life of the Region.

CLUB OF THE YEAR

- An outstanding sports club who has catered for its members in an exceptional manner in the 2007/08 specified year.
- Has competed within the region in a range of grades at a high level.
- The clubs members have competed with a sense of fair play.
- Has made a contribution to the community, the sport and the region.



CONDITIONS OF NOMINATION

1. The winners shall be selected by an invited Selection Panel, from the nominations submitted prior to the closing date. The Panel may, at its discretion, seek further nomination of persons, who in the opinion of the Panel are deserving of consideration for an award.
2. The Selection Panel, consisting of Bay of Plenty sport journalists and personalities has the discretion to make judgments on the conditions of the nomination. The decision of the Panel shall be final.
3. From all nominations received (except the Service to Sport award) the Panel will be making a shortlist, to no more than a maximum of five finalists for each category in the open sections.
4. Nominees must be members of a club, school, or sporting organisation in the region bounded by Sport Bay of Plenty's coverage area (bounded by the coastline as far South-East as Whangaparaoa, Athenree in the North, Broadlands in the South and East of the Kaimais).
5. If a club, school, or sporting organisation for a particular sporting code does not exist within the boundaries of Sport Bay of Plenty's coverage area, then the nominee must reside within the boundaries of Sport Bay of Plenty's coverage area.
6. The Open Junior sports person category is for sports persons aged 15 – 21 years and include male and female nominations with a focus on achievements outside of secondary school activities or events not sanctioned by the NZSSSC.
7. The Service to Sport Award is to recognise volunteers, officials and administrators who have gained significant appointments and / or have contributed outstanding service to sport over time. One person per sport will be recognised on the night.
8. Nominations will not be accepted after the deadline date of 12 Noon on Thursday, 9th October 2008.
