(Exceptions may be given to younger students if the athlete has performed exceptionally within the given period) Individuals that compete in sports not sanctioned by the New Zealand Secondary School Sport Association are eligible under the Open Junior Sports Person of the year.

Open to any coach of a secondary school team or individual.

#### **EVES REALTY GIRLS TEAM OF THE YEAR**

Open to girls teams that have performed to exceptional standards during the year.

#### **EASTPACK BEST STUDENT CONTRIBUTION TO SPORT**

Open to any student who has provided an outstanding service to sport in their school.

#### **MARATHON VISUAL MEDIA SERVICE TO SPORT**

Open to any individual volunteer / Sport Administrator who has provided outstanding service to sport within secondary schools.

## **CRITERIA / GUIDELINES FOR AWARD CATEGORIES**

### **SPORTSWOMAN & SPORTSMAN OF THE YEAR**

- An outstanding Sports Person who has performed to an exceptional level in the 2007/08 specified year.
- A sportsperson who has represented their school and region with distinction.
- Has performed with a sense of Fair play.
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to their sport, school and the region.

### **COACH OF THE YEAR**

- Has made an outstanding contribution in the area of coaching in the 2007/08 specified year.
- Achieved results at the highest possible level within their sport.
- Has showed an innovative approach to coaching.
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to the sport, school and the region.
- Has performed with a sense of Fair play.

### **TEAM OF THE YEAR (GIRLS & BOYS)**

- An outstanding Team who has performed to an exceptional level in the 2007/08 specified year.
- A team who has represented their school and region with distinction.
- The team performed with a sense of Fair play.
- Has made a contribution as an ambassador to their sport, school and the region.

### **BEST STUDENT CONTRIBUTION TO SPORT**

- Open to any student who has provided an outstanding service to sport in their school.

### **SERVICE TO SPORT**

- Open to any individual volunteer / Sport Administrator who has provided outstanding service to sport within secondary schools.



## CONDITIONS OF NOMINATION

1. The winners shall be selected by an invited Selection Panel, from the nominations submitted prior to the closing date. The Panel may, at its discretion, seek further nomination of persons, who in the opinion of the Panel are deserving of consideration for an award.
2. The Selection Panel, consisting of Bay of Plenty sport journalists and personalities has the discretion to make judgement on the conditions of nomination. The decision of the Panel shall be final.
3. From all nominations received the Panel will be making a shortlist, to no more than a maximum of four finalists for each secondary school category.
4. Nominees must be members of a club, school, or sporting organisation in the region bounded by Sport Bay of Plenty's coverage area (bounded by the coastline as far South-East as Whangaparaoa, Athenree in the North, Broadlands in the South and East of the Kaimai's).
5. Secondary school categories are open to students of Year 11 and above status and are only related to school representation and/or school sport in events sanctioned by the NZSSSC. Age exceptions may be made for outstanding younger secondary school students who have achieved outstanding results. Schools are within the bounded area as described in (4) with the inclusion of Taupo and Turangi Schools.
6. The Open Junior sports person category is for sports persons aged 15 – 21 years and include male and female nominations with a focus on achievements outside of secondary school activities or events not sanctioned by the NZSSSC.
7. Nominations will not be accepted after the deadline date of 12 Noon on Thursday, 9<sup>th</sup> October 2008.
