## TTPCA Regional V1 trials 15 December 2018

Kia ora whānau, this pānui is an update on information that has been provided on the Waka Ama NZ website with regards to our up and coming V1 trials.

### Key information:

- Registrations extended to 5<sup>th</sup> December (registrations will not be accepted on the day).
- Roster closes 8<sup>th</sup> December and TTPCA will issue invoices.
- Last day for payment from clubs **13<sup>th</sup> December** (please ensure to put your club as reference so that we can identify payment).
- Final lane draw available **13<sup>th</sup> December.**
- Race day **15<sup>th</sup> December.**

### V1 information:

- All canoes must comply with Section 7.1 of the WANZ rules, so V1's must weigh 16kg or over. The committee/race director will conduct spot checks before and after races. **Paddlers whose waka are found under 16kg will be disqualified.** A scales will be available on the day.
- Junior paddlers Please ensure that those of our younger junior paddlers are competent to paddle a rudderless waka, so as to not impede another waka.
- Please ensure that you have sufficient waka available so that you do not hold up races. Some regional waka will be available but dependent on condition of waka.
- You are only permitted to race in the division you are trialling for. This is to ensure that we get through races efficiently. Please do not race in two divisions as this causes issues with the finish line team.
