High tide at 8.17am Low tide at 2.35 pm

Location: Mokotahi, Te Mahia. Mahia Pennisula

6a.m. Arrive, Rigging, Registration opens at 7am

Karakia 7.30am

Race briefing 10 km 8am

Race start 10 km 8.30am

Start with one paddler on the beach – all divisions

(Men, Women, Mixed)

Race briefing 21 km 10am

Race start 21 km 10.30am

Start with one paddler on the beach – all divisions with the exception of J16s (Men, Women, Mixed)

Both races, one runner from the crew finishes between the flags on the beach

Prizegiving 1.30pm or 20 mins after last waka arrives



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Safety Check List

This equipment is required for your safety, cheating the safety checks only endangers you and/or your crew. Any waka found racing without required equipment will be disqualified.

Required Safety Equipment for each W6

- **1** x Cell phone (*in individual Waterproof Bag*) or **1** x Flare (*in individual Waterproof Bag*)
- 2 x spare paddles
- 2 x bailers
- **1** x 25 30m Tow Rope (attached to Waka).
- Spray skirts are compulsory
- Waka must carry one lifejacket, or personal flotation device (PDF) for every person on board (Junior 16yrs must wear jackets during race).

Please print, read and sign the waiver form to hand in to registration on the morning before your race.

Please note that if you wish to paddle in both races, both race fees will apply. J16 paddlers are only eligible to race the 10km race.

Prizes: First waka in for the 10km and the 21km race will receive their entry fee back. In the event of a draw the prize money will be shared between the waka who arrive first.

Spot Prizes: will be drawn at the prizegiving, 1.30pm
