*Paddle from Otahuhu to Mangere Bridge go under bridges **Turn around at bouy Onehunga return to festival Mangere Bridge. Finish.*** **5km**

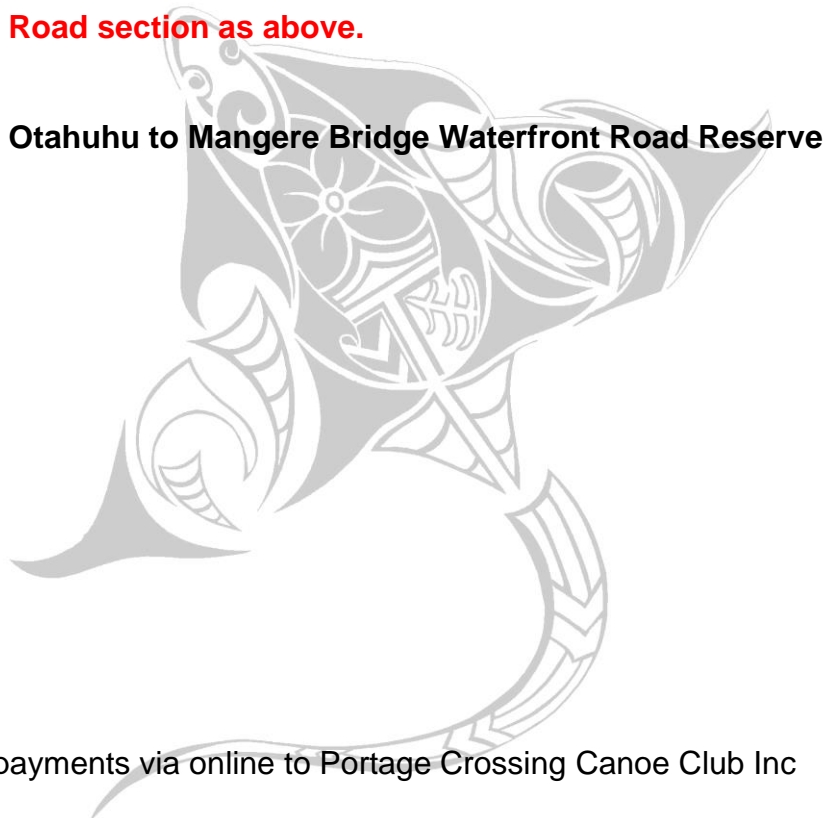
