


Trailer Parking Guidelines

Waka Drop off zones

- Takapuna Boat ramp (by café) – The Promenade



This area is reserved at the times listed, this if for trailers to drop off waka not to park. Once unloaded trailers can be taken to Henderson Park. See instructions for parking later in document. There will be some volunteers onsite during event time. If waka are being delivered outside of the event schedule unloading needs to be arranged by the club. End carpark by Toilet block/Playground – The Strand



This area is all allocated to drive in and unload waka. As with the boat ramp if waka are delivered outside of standard event times the unloading must done by the delivering clubs.

IMPORTANT

-

There is very limited access to the reserve itself. Permit guidelines are very specific around what vehicles can access the reserve and strict safety requirements around the access lane restrictions. This is due to the playground onsite and safety being paramount.

Security will be onsite and only allowing those on the event permit through the access point. All waka will have to be transported from drop off areas to the reserve with trolleys. If you can bring trolleys with you it will be helpful.
