Course Maps

Course maps are subject to change if weather dictates. Paddlers will be fully informed at race briefing. The course maps will be on display at registration.

W1 Rudder and Rudderless

Organisers have decided to align with LDN and recognise separate divisions for W1 Rudder and Rudderless. Paddlers must register their correct division on race day (with safety check and allocation of race number).

Registration

Registration can be found in the new navigators room (see HQ on the sitemap). Waiver Forms will be available on the day though you are welcome to print and bring your completed form with you to registration. Registration opens 6.00am.

Life Jackets

All J16 competitors must wear Maritime New Zealand (MNZ) approved non-inflatable flotation devices for the duration of their event.

Tyres

The ramp and surrounding surfaces are concrete. Bring plenty of tyres to lay under your waka and ama.

Waka Drop Off Instructions

To meet event permit conditions, the committee agreed to minimize traffic impact on The Landing. All W1 and W6 waka are to be onsite Friday between 7-9pm.

Clubs dropping off W6 bring at least 3-4 helpers to assist with unloading and placing on the

Clubs dropping off W6, bring at least 3-4 helpers to assist with unloading and placing on the ramp. Rigging after waka unloaded is optional. Traffic Marshalls will be on duty. Follow their direction for safe delivery of your waka. **Security** will be onsite Friday 6pm to 6am Saturday.

W6 Trailer Parking

Trailers can park overnight in a designated public parking area. Saturday morning, park your vehicle with your trailer, purchase a parking ticket and display in your window.

W6 Trailer Park Cost Reimbursement

AROCA will reimburse the cost of one trailer park per club. Purchase your parking ticket Saturday morning, take a photo of the ticket and send your photo to Danelle by email admin@aroca.co.nz to ensure you are reimbursed the parking fee before you leave The Landing.

General Parking

Pay and Display public parking is available on The Landing on a first in, first served basis. Thereafter, there is public parking available on Tamaki Drive, Okahu Street, Watene Cres and Reihana Street.

Please note – there is another event on at The Landing

Weather Conditions or Other Delays

In case of severe weather conditions on race day, the race director retains the right to stop, postpone and/or cancel races on race day. Please note that in the event of cancellation, we will be unable to refund race fees in this case.

Payment Instructions

All entry fees are to be paid by 6th March. Clubs will be able to see roster and invoice details on the members area of the website. A follow up invoice will also be sent to clubs. Any late entries that are accepted will be invoiced separately.

Crew entries with an incomplete roster at the entry closing date will be treated as per paddler per event (W1& W6) and invoiced accordingly (no discount for the multiple event will be applied).

All clubs must pay directly to the AROCA account and ensure the reference is clear to ensure payment is reconciled. One payment per club only.

Paddler Fees are non-refundable. If a paddler is withdrawn after the entries close date they forfeit their fee. Crews from a club with outstanding fees will not be allowed to participate.

W1s

Clubs and Coaches please note that your paddlers must be of a level where they can competently and confidently take the start line and complete the race. All W1's must have a bailer regardless of whether the canoe has a foot pump.

Race Numbers

All waka will be issued with their own adhesive waka number.
