All races, one runner from the crew finishes between the flags on the beach. We will endeavour to stick to the race time frames, but if a race is delayed, that may affect the start times of the following races. Prizegiving 2.30pm or 20 mins after last waka arrives

Safety Check List

This equipment is required for your safety, cheating the safety checks only endangers you and/or your crew. Any waka found racing without required equipment will be disqualified.

Required Safety Equipment for each W6

- **1** x Cell phone (*in individual Waterproof Bag*) or **1** x Flare (*in individual Waterproof Bag*)
- 2 x spare paddles
- **2** x bailers
- **1** x 25 30m Tow Rope (*attached to Waka*).
- Spray skirts, be prepared with spray skirts. The race director will decide according to conditions on the day whether or not they are to be worn.
- Waka must carry one lifejacket, or personal flotation device (PDF) for every person on board (Junior 16yrs must wear jackets during race).

Waiver form

Please print, read and sign the waiver form to hand in to registration on the morning before your race.

Entry Fees

W6 10km race \$90 per waka/\$15 per paddler W6 21km race \$150 per waka/\$25 per paddler W1 and W2 10km race \$15 per paddler W12 5km race \$120 per waka/\$10 per paddler

Race registration closes on the 24th March @ 11.59pm.

Registration for races is online via your club representative. Race fees include a post race meal supplied by our Taitamariki paddler whānau from Te Māhia. One meal per paddler irrespective of how many races you have entered.

Please note that if you wish to paddle in more than one race, all race fees will apply. J16 paddlers are only eligible to race the 10km and 5km races.
