- wakaama Outrigger / Va'a / New Zealand
- *Teams will consist of 11 paddlers, the 12th paddler (the steerer) can be provided if needed.
- Teams must have at least 50% women minimum i.e. you can have more women than men, but not more men than women
- Teams can be connected with a local club for trainings. PLEASE NOTE: This is at your own expense and at the discretion of the club
- Race Distance will be 250m on our world-class race course at Lake Karāpiro
- Cost per team is \$1000+ GST
- If one organisation cannot field a full W12 team, we are happy for two organisations to combine (6 paddlers each) to make up a W12. The cost would then be split between the two organisation \$500 each.
- All teams will get at least 2 races throughout the day this is an all-day event
- Lunch will be provided for paddlers only
- Paddlers must be employees or contractors of your organisation
- If any of your paddlers are racing in club teams club races will not be disrupted or changed to accommodate those paddlers.
- The Corporate Challenge awards ceremony will be at the end of the racing day and included in our club championship prizegiving
- Please note our event is drug, smoke and alcohol free. We are a whānau event
