QUALIFYING EVENT UPDATE - 25 March

We are planning for this event to take place under the RED traffic light setting with the following changes:

For the W6 Racing (Saturday 9th April):

- Club crews will be split into 3 sessions
- Each session will run for 2 hours and will include
 - a Course familiarisation time
 - Simulation Race (W6 500, W6 Turns, W12)

MATAHINA HIRE

Thanks to our PCKC whānau we will have 2 x Matahina V6 onsite - these are the official race canoes for the World Sprints Event in August.

Matahina will be booked out in 30 minute time slots - this should be booked outside of your team's W6 session on Saturday and outside of times that clash with your paddler's V1 races on Sunday.

There is a \$30 booking fee (per canoe, per session) - Waka Ama NZ will invoice Clubs once bookings have been made. Once payment is received - your booking will be confirmed. Booking fees will be given by Waka Ama NZ to PCKC. The Matahina will be set up outside of the event area on the day (refer to the site map). You will be briefed with more details closer to the event regarding water access etc.

W1 Waka Weighing

We are using a new process at this event - It will hopefully make things a little easier for everyone.

- W1 Waka must all weigh a minimum of 16kgs (fully rigged)
- We will not be weighing waka prior to the racing.
- The first 3 Waka in each race will be weighed when they come off the water.
- There may also be random checks on random waka throughout the day.
- You are responsible for ensuring that your waka has weights in it when you race if it needs weighing up
- It is your responsibility to ensure that your waka weighs 16kg when you race.

We will have the scales set up prior to races and you are welcome to weigh your waka yourself on our official scales to check its weight prior to racing.
