### COVID-19 & TRAVEL

The IVF has reviewed the Covid-19 protocols and due to UK Government Covid-19 regulations recently changing, vaccination will not be a requirement of participation/attendance at the World Elite and World Club Sprint Championships.

Given the evolving and changing nature of the international Covid-19 situation, the IVF and GB Outrigger encourage all those attending the event to be fully vaccinated against Covid-19 before travelling to the UK. It is advised that you closely monitor the Covid-19 situation if you intend on travelling to the UK. Regulations can change at any time, as we have seen over recent months. ### For non-vaccinated travellers (updated 22 March 2022)

From 11:59pm 18 March 2022, most travellers entering New Zealand will be able to self-test on arrival and will no longer need to enter Managed Isolation and Quarantine (MIQ). MIQ will only be used in limited circumstances — for example, for some maritime and international air crew.

These travellers are now no longer required to enter MIQ when they arrive in New Zealand:

- unvaccinated New Zealand citizens
- non-New Zealand citizens who meet the vaccination requirements to enter New Zealand, unless they are exempt.

#### **General Travel Guidance**

Each airline and destination may have different requirements and it is your responsibility to understand what you need to do for your entire trip, including connecting flights and your visa, entry, vaccination, testing and quarantine requirements for your return. Failure to meet these requirements may result in denied boarding at the airport.

All travellers should make sure they review all information related to COVID-19 (including but not limited to what we have provided). Should you have any questions or concerns regarding your travel arrangements for the IVF World Sprints in London in August, we would advise you to speak directly to your travel agent or airline

# PADDLER INFORMATION DUE 6<sup>th</sup> May 2022

Due to the number of Aotearoa Paddlers, we have set **6**<sup>th</sup> **May deadline** for the following:

### REPRESENTATIVE LETTERS – ON REQUEST

### **UNIFORMS**

Waka Ama NZ logo is available for use (by request). Should you wish to use the logo simply request the graphic from <a href="worlds@wakaama.co.nz">worlds@wakaama.co.nz</a>.

### **Guidelines for use:**

- WANZ logo may be used on club racing uniforms
- WANZ logo may be used on club off the water uniforms
- WANZ logo should be no bigger than 10cmx10xcm
- WANZ logo can be placed on the breast of the garment
- WANZ logo can be one colour print (white or black) or can be 3 colours as per the above logo
- WANZ logo must not appear on uniform items that are to be sold for fundraising





The WANZ logo must not be altered

**Off the Water T-shirt:** Waka Ama NZ will provide to all World Club Championship competitors an 'off the water' tshirt which is to be worn at the Opening Ceremony. Teams will be distributed one (1) shirt per paddler, and up to a maximum of 3 Club Managers – in the event individuals are engaged in multiple roles there will only be one shirt per person.

### **PASSPORTS**

Please ensure all paddlers and supporters going to London have valid passports to travel. We urge all travellers to check the expiry dates of your passports now. It is recommended to include validity beyond the date you are due to return to cover for any unforeseen circumstances.

New Zealand passport holders may generally enter the UK for six (6) months without a visa on a visa waiver if they are here for a holiday. However, you will still need to satisfy a Border Force officer when you arrive that you meet the requirements of your visitor category, and aren't in the UK for any other purpose.
