TRAVEL

All travellers should make sure they review all information related to COVID-19 (including but not limited to what we have provided). PASSPORT VALIDITY:

Passports must be valid for the duration of your stay in the United Kingdom (At least six months remaining validity is required for onward travel to many other countries). Now is a good time to check the expiry dates of your passports, with lots of time if you need to organise a new one!

CLUB OFF THE WATER SHIRT ORDER & INFORMATION SHEET

This will be sent out to each club coordinator. This sheet will include all qualified teams from within your club populated with your paddlers names from the roster. We are asking that you

- A. Nominate up to 3 managers who are travelling with your club (for the bigger clubs) and complete their contact details
- B. Complete the OTW shirt order for your paddlers. Any additional shirts ordered will be invoiced and must be paid for before despatch.
- C. Please ensure all paddlers hold a current affiliation to Waka Ama NZ and must be on your Club Roster

In order to obtain a letter confirming a team or paddlers qualification to the World Club Championships – we will need your roster completed online as confirmation.

Please note club paddlers can request a letter stating that they are representing their club at the World Club Championships. V1 and Elite Paddlers will receive a letter confirming they are representing Aotearoa.

LOGO USE AND EVENT BRANDING

Team paddling uniforms must not carry sponsors logos. Team uniforms are to be free of sponsors logos. The only company logo permitted is the brand or mark of the uniform garment which can appear as a small logo on one side of the chest (For example Nike, Adidas). Country and/or Club name and country/club symbols/logo may appear anywhere on the racing uniform.

WANZ LOGO

WANZ logo available for use (by request): WANZ have made available a logo for use on race shirts and off water wear. Should you wish to use the logo simply request the graphic from worlds@wakaama.co.nz

Guidelines for use:

- WANZ logo may be used on club racing uniforms
- WANZ logo may be used on club off the water uniforms
- WANZ logo should be no bigger than 10cmx10cm
- WANZ logo can be placed on the breast of the garment
- WANZ logo can be one colour print (white or black) or can be 3 colours as per the above logo
- WANZ logo must not appear on uniform items that are to be sold for fundraising
- The WANZ logo must not be altered

EVENT LOGO

No paddler, team or member federation is permitted to use the official event logo or official event graphics on their uniform designs or for any other purpose.

The Design

The main pattern that is across all the uniforms is Puhoro. This pattern speaks to the movement and speed of water. In this case, the ability of our Kaihoe to move and cut across the water rapidly, striving to victory. This particular pattern is often found on the tauihu of traditional waka and also commonly referred to as the main pattern that is tattooed onto the legs of own people - emphasising speed agility and the ability of the wearer to embody those characteristics.
