The 10km regatta will be started by Hon Michael Woods Minister of transport, by lowering flag on bridge at 10.45am.

• All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.

 - Spare Paddle 2 for a W6, 1 for W1/2
 - Spray Skirt (W6)
 - Tow Rope (W6)


INDIVIDUAL & TEAM WAIVERS
