# **RACE DAY INFORMATION**

**Car Parking:** Parking is available in the reserve and between the reserve and the boat ramp.

Roadside parking should be in a manner that **does not block** access to driveways.

**<u>Trailer parking:</u>** Trailer parking is between the boat ramp and the reserve

<u>Food:</u> We encourage you to bring your own healthy kai, however a small range of food vendors will be available onsite to purchase healthy kai.

**Toilets:** Toilets are located in the reserve.

First Aid: First Aid will be available at the registration tent.

<u>Rubbish/Recycling:</u> We encourage you to please take what you bring. However, the main rubbish will be located by the main toilet block.

<u>Alcohol/Smokefree:</u> Alcohol, smoking, vaping and any other substance use is not permitted at this event, including all premises of the event.

#### Waka Drop off:

- Waka drop off will be available from Friday afternoon
- Waka drop off will be on the beach front via the boat ramp
- Trailer parking is between the boat ramp and the reserve

# **Safety Checks:**

 All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.

# **SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

- All waka must be Safety Checked
- All taitamariki, intermediate and J16 age divisions must wear life jackets
- All J19 and Senior (Open and above) must have the following safety equipment for their races:
  - PFD Personal Floatation Device (per person)
  - Bailers

#### **INDIVIDUAL & TEAM WAIVERS**

- Individual and Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian




# **COURSE MAPS**
