### RACE DAY INFORMATION

**Car & Trailer Parking:** Parking is available around the lake side

## SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All waka must be Safe
- All taitamariki and intermediate age divisions must wear life jackets
- All kaihoe must be competent swimmers and paddlers

## INDIVIDUAL & TEAM WAIVERS

- Individual and Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
- Waivers can be handed in at the managers meeting on the day
