

Waka Drop Off/Rigging/Trailer Parking


Hazard Road carpark for all waka drop off and trailer parking. The Traffic Management team will be there to guide you.

Clubs towing waka are welcome to drop trailers off Friday evening between 5 – 9pm onsite.



General Parking

Registration

Online entries are to be completed using the WANZ online entry system <u>George Pomana Memorial Regatta (Sanctioned) - Waka Ama NZ</u>

- All entries to be completed through your club admin.
- No entries on the day, no exceptions!
- Entries close on 16 May 2023 at 11:59pm
- Rosters close on 17 May 2023 at 11:59pm.

Race Day Info

<u>Car Parking</u>: Parking is available inside the venue in the car park area or street parking is available. **<u>Trailer parking</u>**: Trailer parking will be in main carpark.

Food: All paddlers will receive a soup & fry bread. They can be collected from boathouse at the conclusion of your race/s.

Toilets: Toilets are available at the venue in carpark.

First Aid: First Aid will be available at the registration tent.

Results


All results will be posted on the day and emailed to WANZ for uploading to the event page.
