Pakuranga Outrigger Canoe Club is proud to host the W6 RAMP CHAMPS on Saturday 2nd September 2023, at Nga Hau Maiangi, 252 Panama Road, Mt. Wellington, Auckland.

There are two races, one category per race, only 10kms and prize money up for grabs for the first three placings in each race.

1st Place Team Prize \$900.00

2nd Place Team Prize \$720.00

3rd Place Team Prize \$540.00

How to enter

Entries must be completed online by your club coordinator through the Waka Ama NZ (WANZ) website online entries <u>Events - Waka Ama NZ</u>

Both races are open to Junior (J16/19) and Seniors. All paddlers must be registered with WANZ to be eligible to race on the day. All WANZ race rules apply.

Deadlines

- Entries close <u>Tuesday 29th August 2023</u>
- Paddler roster closes on <u>Wednesday 30th August 2023</u>
- All paddlers must be affiliated to a Waka Ama Club and Waka Ama NZ
- \$50 entry fee per paddler to be paid prior to race day. Clubs will be invoiced by Pakuranga payment to be made to the invoiced account or payment can be made online to:

Participants

This race is open to Junior (J16/19) and senior paddlers that are experienced and capable of finishing the race within a reasonable time. Teams may be a combination of different age groups J16-70+ and a combination of experience. There will be one women's race and one men's race. There are no mixed divisions.

Cancellation

Trailer parking

Trailer parking will be in the designated gated areas provided.

Food

First Aid

First Aid will be available at the registration tent.

Safety Checks

All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.


- All waka must be Safety Checked
- All Junior (J16 & J19) and Senior (Open and above) must have the following safety equipment for their races:
 - PFD Personal Floatation Device (per person)
 - Bailers
 - Flare or cell phone in waterproof case
 - Spare Paddle 2 for a W6

Team Waivers

- Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
- Waivers to handed in at registration on the day
- Team waivers will be provided at registration, or they can be found on our event page on the Waka Ama NZ website.
