## **AGE DIVISIONS & RACE EVENTS**

This race is open to novice, junior (J16/J19) and senior paddlers. All novice and junior teams must have an experienced steerer. Teams racing in the novice category can be a combination of different age groups J16 – M70+. All paddlers must be affiliated to a Waka Ama club and Waka Ama NZ.

Senior paddlers are encouraged to assist novice teams (eg by steering) in the short course. There is no extra cost for senior paddlers also competing in both long and short course event.

- No entries on the day, no exceptions
- Entries close on *Tuesday 22 August 2023*
- Rosters close on Wednesday 23 August 2023, rosters must be completed by close date, no exceptions
- Clubs will be invoiced by Hoe Tonga.

#### **SAFETY REQUIREMENTS**

- All waka must be Safety Checked
- All paddlers and teams must have the following safety equipment for their races:
  - PFD Personal Floatation Device (per person)
  - Bailers
  - Flare or cellphone in waterproof case
  - Spare Paddle 2 for a W6
  - Spray Skirt (W6)
  - Tow Rope (W6)

### **TEAM WAIVERS**

- Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
