RACE DAY INFORMATION

<u>Parking:</u> Car Parking is available around the lake side - however, we ask that W1s are brought over to the paddock behind Registration as load out for events will be from <u>Food:</u> We encourage you to bring your own healthy kai.

The twelve fastest times in the J19 and Premier Dash will form the TTPCA Regional W12. Once the crews are determined, Rutene Gabel will Co-ordinate the Men's Regional 12 and Chev Reti will Co-ordinate the Women's Regional 12 for Nationals 2024.

W1 CANOES and PADDLERS

Registration and Loading Bay:

- Kaihoe may enter only one age group per event.
- W1 canoes need to be brought to the Loading Bay paddock behind Registration (See Map). Paddlers and canoes will funnel through to Load Out prior to their race
- All paddlers must come through Registration prior to their race. Lane Numbers will be issued as canoes line up at Loading Bay. Ensure you are at Registration/ Load Out two races prior to your race.
