RACE DAY INFORMATION

Car Parking: Parking is available by street parking. Please note all parking is under Auckland Council management, you will need to read the signs and park accordingly.

Trailer parking: Trailer parking will be at the Maraetai Boat Ramp as marked and signed.

Food: Healthy Kai will be provided to all paddlers on site by Pakuranga Outrigger Canoe Club.



Toilets: Toilets are located at the far end of the driveway, past the main registration tent.

First Aid: First Aid will be available next to the registration tent, via the main driveway.

Rubbish/Recycling: We encourage you to please take what you bring. However, there will be two rubbish and recycling stations located by the catering tent.

Alcohol/Smokefree: Alcohol, smoking, vaping and any other substance use is not permitted at this event, including all premises of the event.

WAKA DROP OFF & SAFETY CHECKS

Waka Drop off:

- Waka drop off will be available from 7.00am on the event day
- Waka drop off will be inside Maraetai Park, please bring your own trolley.
- Trailer parking is at the Maraetai Boat Ramp. Please only park here if you have trailers.

Safety Checks:

- All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any waka not marked will not be permitted to race.

All entrants must be familiar with the Waka Ama New Zealand race and safety rules.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All waka must be Safety Checked
- All paddlers must have the following safety equipment for their races:
 - PFD - Personal Floatation Device (per person)
 - Bailers
 - Flare or cellphone in waterproof case
 - Spray Skirt (W6)
 - Tow Rope (W6)

INDIVIDUAL & TEAM WAIVERS

- Individual and Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
