Selection Plan and Process Outline

INTENT PROCESS:

Anyone who meets the Eligibility Criteria may submit their intents.

Paddlers wishing to submit intents and be considered for the squad and ultimately the team should complete the attached Intent form and return it to Waka Ama NZ worlds@wakaama.co.nz no later than 8th January 2023.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

To be considered for Para Mixed team paddlers must:

- Be classified by the IVF or eligible to be classified
- The Para Team must meet the IVF Rules and Classification requirements.
- For the V6 there must be 2 Females in the crew and the team cannot exceed a total classification number of <u>18</u> (18 is determined by the sum of the VL1, VL1a, VL2, VL3, VL4 classified paddlers)
- For the V12 there must be 4 Females in the crew and the team cannot exceed a total classification number of <u>36</u> (36 is determined by the sum of the VL1, VL1a, VL2, VL3, VL4 classified paddlers)

- Be a current an affiliated Waka Ama New Zealand member
- Be New Zealand Citizen or have resided in New Zealand for 6 months or longer at the time of the event
- Be at least **16** in the year of competition
- Be endorsed by their club, Intent form must be signed by Club Rep
- Be committed to the process and attend all required trainings
- Communicate with the Coaching/Management in a timely fashion
- Meet all financial obligations
- Be the best you can be and train for performance

Due to the nature of Para-racing, paddler selections will be responsive to the para community. The foundation selection criteria are;

- Commitment
- Attitude
- Ability to work as a team
- Coachability
- Communication Skills
- Classification
