 - 8.15 am - Karakia and Race 1 briefing (Junior and Open 5 km).
 - 8.30 am - Race 1 starts.
 - 9.15 am - Race 2 briefing. (Women and mixed 18 km)
 - 9.30 am - Race 2 starts.
 - 11.15 am - Race 3 briefing. (Men 18km)
 - 11.30 am - Race 3 starts.
- Prizegiving after each race.

RACE DAY INFORMATION.

Kai/Food - Complimentary kai for paddlers. Other kai can be purchased from a nearby Stir Cafe or in town.

Wharepaku/Toilets - are located on the corner of Ferry Road and Redoubt St.

First Aid - Is available from the registration tent.

Car Parking - Parking is available out on the street. Please do not park in the float plane car parks.

Trailer Parking - Trailer parking will be above the bunker on Ferry Road up from the Taupo Yacht Club. Once you have unloaded your waka please move vehicles/trailers to this point.

Registration/Safety Boats checks - These will take place from 7.00 am.

Biosecurity/Gold Clam Checks will also take place at this time. Please follow the biosecurity information on the entry form so that you can be sure you will be able to paddle on the day.

Entry/Payment Cut Off - Cut off for entry/payment is Monday the 24th of June. Can clubs please pay fees in one payment to Taupo Waka Ama Club bank account no. 02-0428-0098029-00.
