Te Uranga o Te Rā in association with Waka Ama New Zealand (WANZ), are proud to host the 2024 Waka Ama Long Distance Nationals (LDNs) to be held at Oneroa (Midway Beach), Gisborne.

IMPORTANT - RACE SCHEDULE CHANGES (further details found pages 7-9)

- ❖ J16 W1 Ruddered/Rudderless events Due to changing the Long Distance Nationals to a 3 day event, and an unintended race clash, we have switched the J16 W1 Women Rudderless event to Race 5, and the J16 W1 Women Ruddered event to Race 3. Both the J16 W1 Men and Women's events will now run concurrently in each discipline.
- * Addition of W4 category Due to requests, we have added a W4 Open category (Men, Women, Mixed) to the event. This has been scheduled in Race 5 and will be contested over the 23 25 km distance.

BACK-UP RACE DAY

If the weather or sea conditions make it unsafe to paddle any one of the allocated races then Sunday October 6th, is the back-up race day. Paddlers are advised to make plans to be available that day.

2024 LDN PŌWHIRI

The powhiri will take place on **Thursday 3rd October 8am**, at the Midway Community Hub/event venue. Closer to the time we will send out a survey link for clubs to let us know how many paddlers/supporters/whānau will be attending the powhiri for catering purposes.





VENUE

- The event will be based at Oneroa/Midway Beach Google map link Midway Beach
- The trailer parking will be at Churchill Park see Site Map
- The Pōwhiri will be on Thursday October 3rd at **8am** onsite at the event Midway Surf Rescue Community Hub. A cup of tea will follow.
- Prizegiving and paddler kai will take place at Awapuni School, Awapuni Rd, Gisborne

ENTRY FEES

The fees for all entries received prior to September 5th are:

Grade	W6/W4	W1 Rudderless/W1 Ruddered/W2	Combination
Seniors	\$60 each	\$60 each	\$90 each
Juniors	\$40 each	\$40 each	\$60 each

NOTE:

- If a senior paddler is entered for one club in both the W6/W4 and W1 Rudderless/W1 Ruddered races the entry fee payable is \$90.00.
- If a Junior paddler is entered for one club in both the W6 and W1 Rudderless/W1 Ruddered races, the entry fee payable is \$60.00.
- Entry into a third event (under the same club) would cost a further \$30.00 for seniors and \$20.00 for Juniors ie: W6 + W1 + W2 or W6 + W4 + W1 = \$120.00/Senior or \$80/Junior.
- If a paddler wishes to paddle for two different clubs, **full entry fees** will be charged for each event entered (\$60+\$60/Senior, \$40+\$40/Junior). The combination discount is not applicable in this case





LATE FEE PENALTIES

Any late additions/changes made after entries close on September 5th 2024, will incur a \$20 per paddler late fee, e.g. division changes, paddler swap, additions.

Any club that withdraws teams after being invoiced will still be charged the full entry fee.

All team entries are to be entered via the Waka Ama New Zealand website through your Club Coordinator.

REFUND POLICY

- No refunds will be given for any withdrawals after September 17th when the roster is closed
- No refund will be given if the event is cancelled due to a natural disaster or extreme weather should the event be cancelled after Monday September 30th, 2024.

VERIFICATIONS

Please ensure all paddlers entered are verified and affiliated, to be able to add their names to the club roster prior to the deadlines.

RACE DISTANCES AND COURSES

The racecourse will be finalised closer to the event date based on the weather and ocean conditions to provide all paddlers with an enjoyable, challenging, and safe experience. Course maps for all alternate courses will be available in the next pānui.

J16 & Novice races will take place at this event and the courses for those will be within the harbour.

RACE DIVISIONS

All age groups are outlined in the Waka Ama New Zealand Race Rules, rule 50.2. <u>Note</u>: J16 minimum age is 11 and J19 Competitors must be a minimum age of 16 in the year of competition.

- All New Zealand entrants must be from clubs affiliated with Waka Ama New Zealand.
- All paddlers must be verified to enter. Entrants from overseas clubs are welcome to register for this event but will not be eligible for medals.
- The adaptive teams must comprise a minimum of 3 adaptive paddlers. The 3 other seats can filled by adaptive or non-adaptive paddlers
- Mixed W6/W4 Crews in mixed races are to be of mixed gender. The majority (at least 50%) of paddlers must be female
- Mixed W2 teams must be made up of 1 man and 1 woman
- Mixed W3 teams must have at least 1 woman
- International entries are permitted but not eligible for medals

IMPORTANT - PADDLING FOR TWO DIFFERENT CLUBS

As per the <u>WANZ Race Rules (50.4)</u>, W1 paddlers may have the option of competing for another club in a W6/W4 event, if the club for which they are registered in the W1 event does not have sufficient numbers to field a W6/W4 crew.

If a W1 (or W2) paddlers are eligible, the following requirements need to be met:

- The paddler must be added to the W1/W2 event first by their primary club
- Their secondary club (W6/W4 team) must email events@wakaama.co.nz to notify WANZ that this paddler is racing across two clubs and which W6 team they must be entered into WANZ will action
- WANZ will verify that the paddler/s are eligible and confirm the entry
- If a paddler wishes to paddle for two different clubs, **full entry fees** will be charged for each event entered (\$60+\$60/Senior, \$40+\$40/Junior). The combination discount is not applicable in this case
- WANZ will invoice each club the applicable fees





COMPETITORS' ABILITY

We are providing opportunities for experienced and capable crews, and individuals in age categories from J16 and above. The term "experienced" means that teams and individuals have experience in sea conditions. All Clubs are responsible for ensuring that all paddlers are competent in the divisions that they have been entered into. The Race Director has the discretion to withdraw a team or an individual who is deemed to be unfit or unprepared to complete the race.

The short course race will provide an opportunity to those paddlers who are experienced, but are unable to complete the senior distance – the short course events will not be eligible for medals. J16 and Short Course events will be held within the Harbour.

WAKA HIRE

W6 Waka Hire - We encourage teams to bring their waka to the LDNs, however we understand that is not as easy for everyone.

Waka Ama NZ has created a sheet for waka hire: 2024 Long Distance Nationals - Waka Hire.

This is for W6 waka hire only. Waka hire must be completed directly between the clubs hiring out and the clubs wanting to hire. All contact information and availability of waka will be shown on the sheet, as hiring clubs begin to list their waka. This sheet is live and automatically updates.

Each club hiring out waka must set their hire fee and must liaise directly with the club wanting to hire to confirm the hire and arrange payment. All Waka Hire information can be found with the information sheet online here: Long Distance Nationals

As part of this partnership, the airline will serve as the preferred airline of Waka Ama NZ and feature at the four major events, working collaboratively with Waka Ama NZ to further develop the sport.
