Due to outgoing tide on race day, race start times may be earlier on the day.

Race 2 will be started as soon as possible after Race 1 is complete.

Competitors from out of town are encouraged to be in New Plymouth the night before to ensure that they do not miss their races.

Kai will be available once all Race 2 competitors safely return (expected to be 12.30). Prize giving shortly after kai.

Race Day Safety Information

This is an Open Sea Race and conditions may change quickly. The event is well supported by safety boats and persons.

Race times are on an outgoing tide with Race 2 at low tide. There are a number of reefs near the race route. These will be marked by a buoy and highlighted in the race briefing.

Crews need to be prepared for these conditions so:

- Full PFD is required. No horseshoe or belt lifejackets will be accepted.
- Spray skirts must be available for the waka. Crews will be provided information on sea and wind conditions and requirement for skirts on race day.
- It is recommended that a spare paddle and spare steerer is on each waka.

Each team must assign a Captain and provide a cell phone number that will be on the waka during the race. This is a part of the safety and rescue procedures for this open sea event.

Competitors Ability

We are providing opportunities for experienced and capable crews aged 19 and above. The term "experienced" means that teams and individuals have experience in OPEN SEA conditions.

All Clubs are responsible for ensuring that all paddlers are fit and competent in the race that they have been entered into.

The Race Director has the discretion to withdraw a team or an individual who is found to be unfit or unprepared to complete the race.

Venue: Ngāmotu Beach



Ngāmotu Beach has great facilities for a whanau day out. Great playground for the kids, large grassed, area for picnic/gazebos etc. Safe Swimming Beach.


<u>Kai:</u> Hot kai for all paddlers is included in the race fee and will be provided inside the Yacht Club after the race.

Supporters and spectators are welcome to purchase kai from local cafes/restaurants. <u>Toilets</u>: Toilets are available inside the Yacht Club and also at the Playground at Ngāmotu Beach.

<u>First Aid</u>: First Aid will be available at the registration tent, via main driveway. **<u>Rubbish/Recycling</u>**: We encourage you to please take what you bring. However, the main rubbish and recycling station is located by the childrens playground.

<u>Alcohol/Smokefree</u>: Alcohol, smoking, vaping and any other substance use is not permitted at this event, including all premises of the event.
