RACE DAY INFORMATION

<u>Car Parking:</u> Parking is available by street parking. Please note all parking is under Taupo Council management, you will need to read the signs and park accordingly.

<u>Trailer parking:</u> Trailer parking will be off street parking. Due to restrictions, this will only be available for trailer drop off – you will need to park your car elsewhere for the day.

<u>Food:</u> We encourage you to bring your own healthy kai, however a Kai will be provided after the race at the prize giving

Toilets: Toilets are located next to the venue

<u>First Aid:</u> First Aid will be available at the registration tent, and also on the water.

<u>Rubbish/Recycling:</u> We encourage you to please take what you bring. However, the main rubbish and recycling station is located by the main toilet block.

<u>Alcohol/Smokefree:</u> Alcohol, smoking, vaping and any other substance use is not permitted at this event, including all premises of the event.

WAKA DROP OFF & SAFETY CHECKS

Waka Drop off:

- Waka drop off will be available from 7.00am on the event day
- Waka drop off will be on the beach front and will be clearly signed with entry & exit
- Trailer parking is on the opposite side of the road, please be aware of your surroundings through this process.

Safety Checks:

- All waka are required to have their spray skirts fitted before the safety check/racing
- All waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.

ONLINE ENTRIES & PAYMENT

- Online entries are to be completed using the Waka Ama NZ online entry system.
- All entries to be completed through your club admin contact them to process your entry
- No entries on the day, no exceptions
- Entries close on 19/10/25
- Rosters close on 19/10/25, rosters must be completed by close date, no exceptions
- Once entered, payment can be made online to:
 - Makoha Trust account
 - 12-3162-0167368-00
 - Use your club, team name and division as your reference

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- Competitors should expect strong winds and be competent in paddling in these conditions.
- All paddlers will be screened before their entry is accepted.
- If weather conditions dictate, the Race Director will instruct all paddlers to wear their life jackets to be able to compete
- All waka must be Safety Checked
- Spray skirts must be fitted to all waka before racing commences.
- All Junior (J19) and Senior (Open and above) must have the following safety equipment for their races:
 - PFD Personal Floatation Device (per person)
 - Railers
 - Flare or cellphone in waterproof case
 - Spare Paddle 2 for a W6,
 - Spray Skirt (W6) fitted onto the waka before racing commences.
 - Tow Rope (W6)
- Each team will be required to download the Windtracker App, and have that live during racing.



INDIVIDUAL & TEAM WAIVERS

- Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
- Waivers can be sent to *taupoCrossing@gmail.com* or handed in at the managers meeting on the day
