RACE DAY INFORMATION

Car Parking: Parking is available in two areas. There is limited parking in the Shelly Beach carpark for competitors only. There is overflow and spectator parking in the reserve above the beach which is a 2 minute walk to the beach. Please follow the signs down James McLeod Rd, onto Roy Hughes Lane and into the reserve. Parking marshals will be there to show you where to park. Disability parking is available in front of the Shelly Beach toilet block.

Trailer parking: Trailer parking will be in the Shelly Beach carpark.



Food: There will be a small range of food vendors available onsite. Some healthy options available. There will be a hangi for pre order. Details to follow.

Toilets: Toilets are located at the beginning of the Shelly Beach Carpark and there will be portaloos located at the end of the Shelly Beach reserve also.

First Aid: First Aid will be available at the Shelly Beach Fire Station

Rubbish/Recycling: We encourage you to please take back what you bring. However, the main rubbish and recycling station is located by the main toilet block.

Alcohol/Smokefree: Alcohol, smoking, vaping and any other substance use is not permitted at this event, including all premises of the event.

WAKA DROP OFF & SAFETY CHECKS

Waka Drop off:

- Waka drop off will be available from 6.00am on the event day
- Waka drop off will be on the beach front landing. Trailer parking is in the Shelly Beach carpark. Please follow our parking wardens instructions.

Safety Checks:

- All Waka will have to pass a safety check and be marked before racing. Any boats not marked will not be permitted to race.

All entrants must be familiar with the Waka Ama Aotearoa New Zealand race and safety rules.

ONLINE ENTRIES & PAYMENT

- Online entries are to be completed using the Waka Ama Aotearoa NZ online entry system.
- All entries to be completed through your club admin – contact your club admin to process your entry
- Entries close on **14 April 2026** (please note that due to limited entries for this event, your entry is not confirmed until payment is made).
- Rosters close on **15 April 2026**, rosters must be completed by close date, no exceptions
- Once entered, payment can be made online to:

- In the unlikely event of a cancellation due to weather events or otherwise no refund will be given.

SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

- All Waka must be Safety Checked
- All competitors must have a life jacket
- All paddlers must have completed a flip drill prior to the race
- All divisions must have the following safety equipment for their races:
 - PFD - Personal Floatation Device (per person)
 - 2 x Bailers
 - Flare or cellphone in waterproof case
 - 2 x Spare Paddles
 - Spray Skirt
 - Tow Rope



TEAM WAIVERS

- Team waivers must be completed by all paddlers/teams
- All paddlers U18 must have their waiver signed by their parent/guardian
